The City will be stepping up enforcement of the junk vehicle ordinance. Any vehicle meeting the descriptions under City Code 3-9 Junk and Abandoned Vehicles, will be issued a 10 day notice to abate the nuisance.

Some things that can declare a vehicle as junk, under City code are: *(this is not a complete list)*

- Vehicle must have current licenses plates installed
- Lacks an engine
- Missing parts
- Flat or missing tires
- Broken lights or glass
- Being used as storage
- Cannot be stored in the open
- Any vehicle which has become the habitat for any vermin or insects.

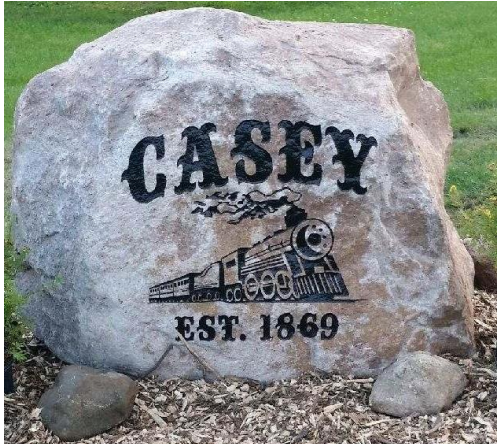
