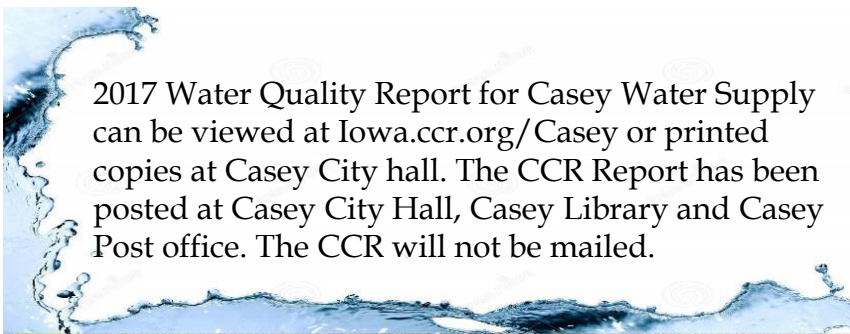

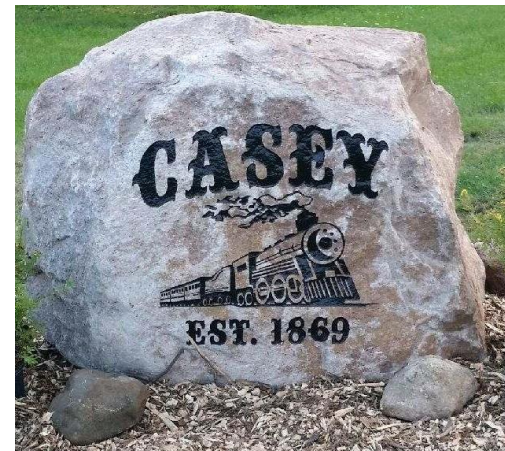
It is your responsibility to mow and trim your entire yard, including ditches, slopes and embankments.

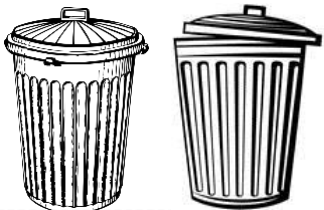


# Facts on what the City Code states about Garbage - Refuse Collection

## City Code 6-4



- ✓ All garbage and rubbish shall be taken from the dwellings at **least once each week** and from public establishments as frequently as the City council may require.
- ✓ Each person shall **provide cans** or **approved containers** for the storage of garbage and rubbish accumulating on the premises owned or occupied by such owner.
- ✓ All storage of garbage/refuse must be drained and placed in a can except as otherwise provided.
- ✓ It is **unlawful for any person to burn** or incinerate any garbage, rubbish, or refuse with the City except by permission of the City Council.
- ✓ Each person shall dispose of all refuse other than garbage and rubbish accumulation on the premises such person owns or occupies before it becomes a nuisance. If it does become a nuisance, it shall be subject to provisions of Title III, Chapter 2 of the City Code



# Facts on what the City Code states about Pets

**4-1-2 LICENSE.** Every owner of a dog or cat over the age of six (6) months shall procure a license from the City Clerk-Treasurer on or before the first day of January of each year. Licenses will become delinquent March 1<sup>st</sup> of each year. (This includes dog/cat that may never go outside, as well)

**4-1-4 AT LARGE PROHIBITED** No owner or person having custody of an animal shall permit such animal to run at large

**4-1-5 ANIMAL NUISANCES.** It shall be unlawful for any person to permit an animal under such person's control or within such person's custody to commit a nuisance.

An animal shall be considered a nuisance if it:

- Damages, soils, defiles or defecates on private property other than the owner's or on public walks and recreation areas unless such waste is immediately removed and properly disposed of by the owner.
- Causes unsanitary, dangerous or offensive conditions.
- Causes a disturbance by excessive barking or other noisemaking or chases vehicles, or molests, attacks or interferes with persons or other domestic animals.

**City code 4-1-7 states Dangerous Animals Prohibited** No person shall keep, shelter, or harbor for any purpose within the City limits, a dangerous animal.

- **Definitions.** A dangerous animal is any animal which is not naturally tame or gentle, and which is of a wild nature or disposition, and which is capable of killing, inflicting serious injury upon, or causing disease among human beings or domestic animals, and having known tendencies as a species to do so. Which include, but not limited to:
  - **Pit bulls** meaning any dog that is an American Pit Bull Terrier, American Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire Bull Terrier, or any dog displaying the majority of physical traits of any one or more of the above breeds (more so than any other breed), or any dog exhibiting those distinguishing characteristics which substantially conform to the standards established by the American Kennel Club or United Kennel Club for any of the above breeds.
