Fichter explained possible additions to the current pet ordinance. Suggestions are a total of three dogs or three cats or four total. Insurance would be required at a \$1 million liability plus a good fenced yard. An individual would have 1-2 months to get tags – if not then enforce with the county. lowa code allows for a civil penalty for \$750 to \$1,000. Wagner suggested that we add this to our code. Fichter is to have changes made to ordinance for consideration at October meeting.

Discussion was held about emotional support animals. Pit bulls need to have documents with certifications. All animals should have documents concerning certifications.

Welker presented bids from Thorpe to acidize well #4 of \$4,600.00 and from Tom Hoy of \$6,200.00.
