

**Casey City Council
Casey Library
September 26th 2018
Special Meeting**

A special meeting of the Casey City Council was held Monday September 26, 2018 at 6:00 p.m. Present was Mayor Barry Chalfant, Councilmembers Nick Lindberg, Stacy Wagner, Rick Richter, Travis Peterson and Bret Wedemeyer. Also present was City Clerk Michelle King, Public works director Jon Welker and City attorney Clint Fichter.

A motion by Peterson and second by Lindberg to approve the agenda as presented. All eyes. Carried.

A motion by Wagner and second by Wedemeyer to approve to pay for a wider counter top in the Clerks payment window All Ayes. Carried.

A motion by Wedemeyer and second by Richter to stay with one light for the flag pole. All eyes. Carried.

Discussion was held on current status of 611 McPherson Street. Some of the past minutes indicated that it was sold to Barry Williams in 2008, the deed had never been filed, and is still in the City of Casey's name. Since no original deed is available Chalfant, Wedemeyer and Wagner will try and reach out to Williams before additional decision are made.

Fichter reviewed his draft of making the entire city an urban renewal area under Slum and Blight. Fichter also provided a draft of the comp plan. Fichter will make some adjustments and changes and will present to the council at a special meeting to be held Friday October 12th at 5pm at the library.

Wagner stated she is following up with King on junk vehicles.
