PET LICENSE DUE

Between Jan. 1 and May 1

Per City Code 4-2 any Dog or Cat over the age of 6 mos. is to be registered with the city.

*A penalty of \$5.00 per week, per animal after 5-1-15 will be charged to the pet owner.

Dog - \$15.00 each, unless spayed/neutered \$3.00

Cats- \$10.00 each, unless spayed/neutered \$3.00

**Senior Citizens can license one pet free of charge, per address*

Proof of spayed/neutered as well as current vaccinations are required**

Per City Code 4-1

It is unlawful and a violation of the City Ordinance to allow your pet:

-to be an annoyance or disturbance in any way. (barking, growling, lunging, chasing any person(s) and/or showing signs of aggression towards someone or another animal)

-run at large at any time

-to be unleashed while outside a secured area

-to be unlicensed by the City (Pet tag must be on animal at all times)

A violation of the City code, for any reason can result in your pet being impounded, as well as a citation for you to appear in Court for said violations. Both of which can cost you additional expense.

PLEASE keep you pets on a lease or in a secure location at all times when out doors. The City does have a lease law.

The City is looking for someone to take on the task of managing the City Park Camping for the 2015 season. For more details or if you are interested please contact City hall before 5-4-15

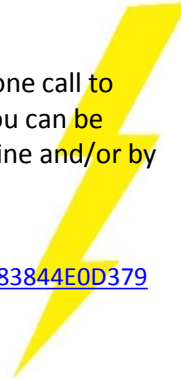
