City Utility Bills

BILLING PROCESS

- City utility bills are sent out on or before the 1st day of each
- Bills are due on the 15th of each month (or the next working day if it falls on a holiday or weekend)
- Delinquent bills, adding a 10% penalty, are processed and sent out on the following working day (usually the 16th); these are due to City Hall with in 12 days (or the next working day if it falls on a holiday or weekend)
- Shut offs delinquent accounts, are processed the follow day.

Please contact City Hall if you have not received your Utility bill with in the first 5 days of the month. A duplicate bill can be reprinted.

PAYMENT AGREEMENTS

If you are in need of making arrangements to get your utility bill current and, possibly avoid disconnection and additional fees, please contact City Hall. If you qualify for a payment agreement, it is required that the new amount billed (new months charges) are paid by the 15th of the month; You will also need to pay the agreement payment by agreed date, to avoid disconnection of services and possible additional charges.

PET LICENSE DUE

Between Jan. 1 and March 1 Per City Code 4-2 any Dog or Cat over the age of 6 mos. is to be registered with the city.

A penalty of \$5.00 per week, per animal after 3-1-15 will be charged to the pet owner.

Cost

Dog - \$15.00 each, unless spayed/neutered \$3.00 Cats- \$10.00 each, unless spayed/neutered \$3.00 Senior Citizens can license one pet free of charge, per address.

Proof of spayed/neutered as well as current vaccinations are required


