The City Continues to work on the NEW City website, please be patient as work continues.

PROPER DISPLAY OF ADDRESS

Per City code it is:

-mandatory to conspicuously display the building number on the portion of the building/premise which faces the street.

-Number size is to be of durable substance, clearly legible and the numerals shall be not less than five (5) inches in height.

-Mandatory Numbering has been in effect since 1/4/2010. -Failure to comply with the City Code, can result in a notice being sent and/or the City installing the numbers and charging accordingly.

Please do your part in insuring that your premise is properly numbered.

This would be beneficial in multiple ways. The City has been contacted by area Fire and Rescue, and have been asked to try and get house numbers installed and visible so in the case of emergencies, they are able to located the address properly and quickly.
